Lane Closure Along State Road (SR) 907/Alton Road Begin Tuesday, September 8 *Between North Bay Road and West 48 Street*

Miami, Fla. – Beginning on Tuesday, September 8 through Wednesday, September 9, 2020, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m., the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close southbound SR 907/Alton Road between North Bay Road and West 48 Street in order to perform drainage improvements.

Motorists traveling along southbound SR 907/Alton Road will be shifted to northbound SR 907/Aton Road, which will be reduced to one travel lane. This closure is part of a Districtwide Drainage Improvement Pushbutton project.

Please remember to use caution when traveling through the construction zone and seek alternate routes if possible. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
