Overnight Lane Closure Along Southbound SW 109 Avenue to S.R. 90/U.S. 41/SW 8 Street

Friday, February 6 from 2 a.m. through 9 a.m.

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will implement a necessary overnight single lane closure on southbound SW 109 Avenue between SW 7 Street and State Road (S.R.) 90/SW 8 Street from 2 a.m. to 9 a.m. on Friday, February 6.

During this time, the southbound turning lane on SW 109 Avenue will remain open, allowing drivers to access S.R. 90/SW 8 Street.

Access to adjacent neighborhoods, businesses, and schools will be maintained. Pedestrian detours will be clearly marked with signage.

Please follow all posted signs and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
