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FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for a Bridge Feasibility Study

Snake Creek Bridge on SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway between Mile Marker (MM) 84 and MM 87

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a public meeting for a bridge feasibility study at Snake Creek Bascule (drawspan) Bridge on SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway between MM 84 and MM 87, in Monroe County. An evaluation of the congestion at the bridge is underway and will provide recommendations for future project development studies.

The public meeting will be held from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Wednesday, April 24, 2019 at the Founders Park Community Room, 87000 Overseas Highway, Islamorada, FL 33036. Graphic displays will be shown during the meeting, and FDOT representatives will be available to discuss the study. Businesses, agencies, and property owners will have the opportunity to provide feedback and discuss bridge concepts in an informal, open-house setting.

The study objectives include:

- Evaluating existing bridge conditions
- Evaluating future transportation conditions
- Developing conceptual design plans for replacing the current bridge with a fixed span bridge
