MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is proud to announce the launch of the 2024 "Put it Down" safety campaign; aimed at raising awareness about the perils of distracted driving. This initiative is scheduled to run from January through the end of March and will employ a multi-faceted approach, leveraging community outreach, social media engagement, Public Service Announcements (PSAs) and various other communication channels to disseminate key safety messages to drivers across Miami-Dade and Monroe counties.
