Ramp Closures at Various Locations Along State Road (SR) 826/Palmetto Expressway and I-95 Begin October 9

As Part of FDOT's Wrong-Way Driving Initiative

MIAMI, Fla. – Beginning Monday, October 9 through Friday, October 13, the following ramps along SR 826/Palmetto Expressway and I-95 will be closed to pave the road:

- Monday, October 9 Northbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway off-ramp to SW 8 Street will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Exit right at West Flagler Street
 - Turn right on SW 87 Avenue to access SW 8 Street
- Tuesday, October 10 Northbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway off-ramp to West Flagler Street will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Exit right to Milam Dairy Road
 - Turn right on Milam Dairy Road to access West Flagler Street
- Wednesday, October 11 Northbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway off-ramp at NW 25 Street will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Exit right to NW 36 Street
 - Turn right on NW 72 Avenue to access NW 25 Street
- Thursday, October 12 Northbound SR 826/Palmetto Expressway off-ramp to NW 36 Street will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Exit right at NW 58 Street
 - Turn right on NW 72 Avenue to access NW 36 Street
- Friday, October 13 Southbound I-95 off-ramp to NW 81 Street will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers can:
 - Exit right at NW 69 Street
 - Turn right on NW 7 Avenue to access NW 81 Street

Drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
