Traffic Shift on Southbound I-95 Begins July 10

Miami, Fla. – On Friday morning, July 10, all travel lanes on southbound I-95 from NW 29 Street to NW 17 Street will be shifted to the left side of the roadway to allow the contractor to continue with concrete pavement replacement activities. To implement the traffic shift, the contractor will close three lanes from NW 29 Street to NW 17 Street on Thursday, July 9 between the hours of 8 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions. The closures are part of the I-395/SR 836/I-95 Design-Build Project that will reconstruct the I-395 corridor from the SR 836/I-395/I-95 (Midtown) Interchange to the MacArthur Causeway Bridge, including the construction of a Signature Bridge over NE 2 Avenue and Biscayne Boulevard; double-deck SR 836 from west of NW 17 Avenue to the Midtown Interchange and the replacement of the concrete pavement on I-95 from NW 8 Street to NW 29 Street.
