SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway Traffic Signal Signage Relocation Begins November 20

*At Tarpon Basin Drive Mile Marker (MM) 101.4 and at Ocean Boulevard (MM 91.2) in
Monroe County*

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will implement daily short-term single lane closures, along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway at Tarpon Basin Drive MM 101.4 and at Ocean Boulevard MM 91.2.

These closures will occur from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Wednesday, November 20 and Thursday, November 21, to relocate traffic signal signage at Tarpon Basin Drive in Key Largo and Ocean Boulevard in Tavernier.

During this period, signal heads at Tarpon Basin Drive will also be repositioned along the mast arm, which will require traffic to be shifted alternately. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times.

Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
