SR 5/US 1/Biscayne Boulevard and SR 922/NE 123 Street Roadway Project Begins the week of November 4, 2024

*From north of NE 105 Street to SR 922/NE 123 Street and along SR 922/NE 123 Street
from NE 16 Avenue to east of N Bayshore Drive*

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project the week of November 4, 2024 along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Biscayne Boulevard from north of NE 105 Street to SR 922/NE 123 Street and along SR 922/NE 123 Street from NE 16 Avenue to east of N Bayshore Drive. The project will last about one year and the current construction cost is \$8.6 million.

The scope of work for this project includes constructing an additional designated westbound left turn lane on SR 922/NE 123 Street to access southbound SR 5/Biscayne Boulevard; extending the eastbound dual left turn lanes to improve the flow of traffic at the intersection; upgrading vehicular and pedestrian signals, drainage pipes and the stormwater pump system to improve capacity; repaving and restriping the road and installing pavement traffic detectors to identify approaching vehicles at the traffic light.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes, sidewalks, and to establish detours at times. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

Detours will be clearly marked. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
