SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway Nighttime Paving Operations Begin Monday, December 2

On Bahia Honda Key from MM 36.6 to MM 38.4

MIAMI, Fla. – Beginning Monday, December 2, 2024, one travel lane will be closed for paving operations on State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway in Monroe County. These nighttime paving operations will take place from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, between Mile Marker (MM) 36.6 and MM 38.4. In the areas with a single travel lane in each direction, flaggers will be present to direct traffic. A lane will always remain open to traffic. To perform this work safely, drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced speed through the construction zone. In areas where there are two travel lanes, one lane will remain open for travel.

Access to and from adjacent neighborhoods, businesses and parks will be maintained throughout construction. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.
