State Road (SR) 90/SW 8 Street Median Reconstruction Begins March 1

At the intersection of SW 137 Avenue

MIAMI, Fla. – Beginning Monday, March 1, travel lanes along eastbound SR 90/SW 8 Street approaching the intersection of SW 137 Avenue will be reduced from a width of 12-feet to 10-feet, to reconstruct the median and traffic separator in this area. This work will last approximately one month.

Travel lanes will remain open but drivers should anticipate delays and seek alternate routes if possible. Please use caution when traveling through the construction zone.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
