State Road (SR) 934/NE 79 Street Causeway from east of Pelican Harbor Drive to west of the bridge guardrail

Roadway Improvement Project Begins Week of May 18

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadside improvement project during the week of May 18, 2020. The project limits extend along SR 934/NE 79 Street Causeway from east of Pelican Harbor Drive to west of the bridge guardrail in the City of Miami. The project will cost an estimated \$472,429.

The work will take approximately three months to be completed. The project includes restoring the grassy area along the eastbound side of the causeway.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. One eastbound lane along the SR 934/NE 79 Street Causeway may be closed from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Mondays through Fridays. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
