### FDOT to Host a Virtual Public Meeting for a Proposed Roundabout on State Road (SR) 972/SW 13 Street/SW 3 Avenue/Coral Way

September 29, 2020

**Miami, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Six will host a Virtual Public Meeting for the design of a roundabout proposed for the intersection of SR 972/SW 13 Street/SW 3 Avenue/Coral Way and SW 15 Road. The meeting will be held from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m., Tuesday, September 29, 2020 via GoToWebinar.

The proposed improvements include: reconfiguring the existing five-legged intersection into a roundabout; constructing a sidewalk around the roundabout; adding Light Emitting Diode (LED) street lights throughout the intersection; upgrading the existing stormwater drainage system; providing high emphasis crosswalks with pedestrian buttons at SW 3 Avenue and SW 15 Road; upgrading signing and pavement markings; and eliminating parking. Construction is expected to begin in June 2023 and last about eight months. The estimated construction cost is \$2.5 million.
