New Roadway Construction Project Begins the Week of July 20, 2020

State Road (SR) 994/Quail Roost Drive

Miami, Fla.— The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of July 20, 2020. The project limits extend along SR 994/Quail Roost Drive at SW 200 Street, in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$550,550.

The work will last roughly five months, and it includes the following: resurfacing, repaving and striping the roadway; upgrading pedestrian ramps, sidewalk and lighting; installing new lighting and traffic signals at the intersection of SW 200 Street, and adding speed feedback signs within the project limits.

To complete this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes at times. Tasks will be done in stages and lane closures will be scheduled to keep traffic moving and avoid special community events.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
