SR 9A/I-95 Ramp Improvement Project Ramp and Travel Lane Closures & Detours

Sunday, February 2 through Saturday, February 8

MIAMI, Fla. – Beginning Sunday, February 2, nightly closures of various ramps and travel lanes will be implemented to perform concrete rehabilitation and repaving and restriping. Work will occur during nighttime hours, from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m.** and detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes.

Sunday, February 2 through Tuesday, February 4

The SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge ramp to SR 5/US1 will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform roadway paving and restriping. During this closure, the ramp from westbound Rickenbacker Causeway to northbound SR 9A/Interstate 95 (I-95) will remain open. The ramp to SR 5/US 1 will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go south on SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/ Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving towards South Miami Avenue and turn left
- Make a right turn onto SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway

SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge Ramp to SR 9A/I-95 will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform roadway paving and restriping. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. During this closure, the ramp from westbound Rickenbacker Causeway to southbound SR 5/US 1 will remain open. The ramp to SR 9A/I-95 will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go north on SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving west onto SW 26 Road
- Turn right at the bend on SW 26 Road, then continue driving towards SW 25 Road
- Use the entrance ramp onto northbound I-95 from SW 25 Road

The entrance ramp from South Miami Avenue towards both directions of SR 9A/I-95 will be closed to allow contractors to perform concrete grinding. This ramp will be closed between 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going south on South Miami Avenue who want to access SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue south on South Miami Avenue
- Turn right on SW 3 Street
- Turn left on SE 1 Avenue
- Turn left on SW 2 Street
- Drive towards South Miami Avenue to reach the entrance ramp to SR 9A/I-95

Tuesday, February 4 through Wednesday, February 5

The SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge ramps to SR 5/US 1 and SR 9A/I-95 will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. to facilitate bridge deck construction and concrete grinding. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. Both ramps will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go south on SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway will:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/ Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving towards South Miami Avenue and turn left
- Make a right turn onto SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go north on SR 9A/I-95 will:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/ Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving west onto SW 26 Road
- Turn right at the bend on SW 26 Road, then continue driving towards SW 25 Road
- Use the entrance ramp onto northbound I-95 from SW 25 Road

The exit ramp from southbound SR 9A/I-95 to SW 25 Road will experience single-lane closures for roadway repaving and restriping. These closures will take place from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

The entrance ramp from South Miami Avenue towards both directions of SR 9A/I-95 will be closed to allow contractors to perform concrete grinding. This ramp will be closed between 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going south on South Miami Avenue who want to access SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue south on South Miami Avenue
- Turn right on SW 3 Street
- Turn left on SE 1 Avenue
- Turn left on SW 2 Street
- Drive towards South Miami Avenue to reach the entrance ramp to SR 9A/I-95

Wednesday, February 5 through Thursday, February 6

SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge Ramp to SR 9A/I-95 will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform approach slab construction and concrete grinding. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. During this closure, the ramp from westbound Rickenbacker Causeway to southbound SR 5/US 1 will remain open. The ramp to SR 9A/I-95 will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go north on SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving west onto SW 26 Road
- Turn right at the bend on SW 26 Road, then continue driving towards SW 25 Road
- Use the entrance ramp onto northbound I-95 from SW 25 Road

Thursday, February 6 through Friday, February 7

SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge Ramp to SR 5/US 1 will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform approach slab construction. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. During this closure, the ramp from westbound Rickenbacker Causeway to northbound SR 9A/I-95 will remain open. The ramp to SR 5/US 1 will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go south on SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/ Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving towards South Miami Avenue and turn left
- Make a right turn onto SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway

The entrance ramp from South Miami Avenue towards both directions of SR 9A/I-95 will be closed to perform concrete grinding. This ramp will be closed between 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate route.

Motorists going south on South Miami Avenue who want to access SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue south on South Miami Avenue
- Turn right on SW 3 Street
- Turn left on SE 1 Avenue
- Turn left on SW 2 Street
- Drive towards South Miami Avenue to reach the entrance ramp to SR 9A/I-95

Friday, February 7 through Saturday, February 8

The exit ramp from SR 9A/I-95 to SE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Boulevard will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform concrete reconstruction. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes, and will reopen by 6 a.m.

Drivers traveling from southbound SR 9A/I-95 who wish to access SE 2 Avenue/Biscayne Blvd should:

- Use the exit ramp towards Miami Avenue and turn right
- Turn right on SW 3 Street
- Turn left on SE 1 Avenue

- Turn right on SE 1 Street
- Continue driving straight towards SE 2 Avenue or Biscayne Boulevard

Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions. Motorists are encouraged to plan accordingly and use alternate routes during the closure periods.
