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### **SR 9A/I-95 Ramp Improvement Project Nightly Ramp Closures Beginning Monday, January 27**

**MIAMI, Fla.** – Beginning Monday, January 27, nightly closures will be implemented to conduct various construction and maintenance activities. These closures are necessary for ongoing maintenance and improvements, including approach slab construction, guardrail adjustments, and road resurfacing. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes.

Crews will be performing repaving and restriping operations throughout the week during nighttime hours at various locations near the entrance/exit ramps, including SW 25 Road, SW 8 Street, South Miami Avenue, SE 1 Avenue and SE 2 Avenue.

#### **Monday, January 27 through Tuesday, January 28**

The entrance ramp from SW 8 Street Inner Loop to northbound SR 9A/Interstate 95 (I-95) will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform concrete slab construction. Drivers should use the Outer Loop ramp as an alternate route during the closure period. The inner loop entrance ramp on SW 8 Street will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

The entrance ramp from SW 25 Road to northbound SR 9A/I-95 will be closed to perform concrete grinding. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. This ramp will be closed between 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists who want to travel northbound on SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue driving east on SW 25 Road
- Turn left on South Miami Avenue
- Turn left on SW 7 Street
- Turn left on SW 3 Avenue
- Use the outer loop entrance ramp from SW 8 Street to access northbound SR 9A/I-95

The exit ramp from northbound SR 9A/I-95 to SR 90/SW 8 Street will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform roadway repaving and restriping. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. The exit ramp will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going north on SR 9A/I-95 who want to access SR 90/SW 8 Street should:

- Continue north on SR 9A/I-95 and use exit 2B towards NW 2 Street
- Turn right on NW 2 Street
- Turn right on SW 2 Avenue and continue driving towards SR 90/SW 8 Street

## **Tuesday, January 28 through Wednesday, January 29**

The SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge ramps to SR 5/US 1 and SR 9A/I-95 will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. to facilitate bridge deck construction and concrete grinding. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. Both ramps will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go south on SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/ Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving towards South Miami Avenue and turn left
- Make a right turn onto SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go north on SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/ Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving west onto SW 26 Road
- Turn right at the bend on SW 26 Road, then continue driving towards SW 25 Road
- Use the entrance ramp onto northbound I-95 from SW 25 Road

The entrance ramp from SW 4 Avenue to southbound SR 9A/I-95 will be closed for repaving and restriping. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. This ramp will be closed between 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists who want to travel southbound on SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue driving east on SR 90/SW 8 Street
- Turn left on SW 2 Avenue
- Turn right on SW 13 Street
- Use the roundabout towards SW 3 Ave/ Coral Way
- Turn left on SR 913/SE 26 Road
- Turn right on South Miami Avenue
- Turn right on SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway

## **Wednesday, January 29 through Thursday, January 30**

SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge Ramp to SR 9A/I-95 will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform approach slab construction and concrete grinding. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. During this closure, the ramp from westbound Rickenbacker Causeway to southbound SR 5/US 1 will remain open. The ramp to SR 9A/I-95 will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go north on SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving west onto SW 26 Road
- Turn right at the bend on SW 26 Road, then continue driving towards SW 25 Road
- Use the entrance ramp onto northbound I-95 from SW 25 Road

## **Thursday, January 30 through Friday, January 31**

SR 913/Rickenbacker Causeway Flyover Bridge Ramp to SR 5/US 1 will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform approach slab construction. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. During this closure, the ramp from westbound Rickenbacker Causeway to northbound SR 9A/I-95 will remain open. The ramp to SR 5/US 1 will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists going west on the Rickenbacker Causeway who want to go south on SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway should:

- Continue west on Rickenbacker Causeway and merge left at the fork towards Coconut Grove/ Brickell Avenue
- Continue driving towards South Miami Avenue and turn left
- Make a right turn onto SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway

The exit ramp from southbound SR 9A/I-95 to SW 25 Road will be closed from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. to perform roadway repaving and restriping. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. This entrance ramp will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists who want to access SW 25 Road from southbound SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue driving south towards SR 5/US 1/South Dixie Highway
- Turn right on SW 16 Avenue
- Turn right on SW 3 Avenue
- Continue driving northbound to reach SW 25 Road

The entrance ramp from SW 25 Road to northbound SR 9A/I-95 will be closed to perform concrete grinding. Detours will be in place to assist drivers with alternate routes. This ramp will be closed between 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will reopen to traffic by 6 a.m.

Motorists who want to travel northbound on SR 9A/I-95 should:

- Continue driving east on SW 25 Road
- Turn left on South Miami Avenue
- Turn left on SW 7 Street
- Turn left on SW 3 Avenue
- Use the outer loop entrance ramp from SW 8 Street to access northbound SR 9A/I-95

## **Friday, January 31 through Saturday, February 1**

The entrance ramp from South Miami Avenue to northbound and southbound SR 9A/I-95 will be closed from 11 p.m. to 3 p.m. for concrete slab replacement work. Detours will be in place to assist drivers in reaching alternate routes. The entrance ramp will reopen to traffic by 3 p.m.

Drivers who want to travel northbound or southbound on I-95 should:

- Continue south on South Miami Avenue
- Turn left onto SW 3 Street and head north towards SE 1 Avenue
- Turn right onto SW 1 Street and head east
- Turn right onto SE 2 Avenue and use the entrance ramp to access I-95 in either direction

## **Saturday, February 1 through Sunday, February 2**

The exit ramp from SR 9A/I-95 to SE 1 Avenue will be closed from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. for concrete slab replacement work. Detours will be in place to assist drivers in reaching alternate routes. The exit ramp will reopen to traffic by 7 a.m.

Drivers who want to travel onto SE 1 Avenue should:

- Continue east towards SE 2 Avenue/ Biscayne Boulevard
- Turn left onto SE 3 Avenue and head north towards SE 2 Street
- Turn left onto SE 2 Street and head westbound to reach SE 1 Avenue

**Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.** Motorists are encouraged to plan accordingly and use alternate routes during the closure periods.
