FDOT to Host a Public Meeting for S.R. 9/NW 27 Avenue Bascule Bridge Rehabilitation Project

November 5, 2025

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an in-person and virtual Public Meeting regarding the design of a bridge rehabilitation project at State Road (S.R.) 9/NW 27 Avenue over Miami River, Bridge #870731 and #870763 starting at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 5, 2025.

This rehabilitation project addresses critical structural, mechanical and electrical deficiencies, and incorporates the modernization of control systems and control house renovations.

Construction is scheduled to start in fall 2027 and last about 20 months. The preliminary construction cost is \$9 million. Please note, schedule and cost are subject to change.

The meeting will consist of a formal presentation followed by an open discussion. Staff will be available to answer questions in the order they are received and as time permits. If your question is not responded to during the meeting, a response will be provided in writing afterwards.
