### New Roadway Construction Project Begins the Week of May 11

*State Road (SR) 9/NW 27 Avenue*

**Miami, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway construction project the week of May 11, 2020. The project limits extend along SR 9/NW 27 Avenue from SR 934/NW 79 Street to SR 932/NW 103 Street, in Miami-Dade County. This project will cost an estimated \$1.5 million.

The work will last roughly nine months and it includes the following: Installing new drainage inlets and pipes to connect to the existing drainage system; reconstructing driveways that restrict waterflow; reconstructing sidewalks, pedestrian ramps, bicycle lanes, and curb and gutter; and repaving and restriping the roadway.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and sidewalks at times. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

**Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.**
