Lane Closures Along Northbound and Southbound SW 137 Avenue at State Road (SR) 90/SW 8 Street Begin May 27

MIAMI, Fla. – Beginning Thursday May 27, one left turn lane of southbound SW 137 Avenue to eastbound SR 90/SW 8 Street and one inside through lane of northbound SW 137 Avenue will be continuously closed for approximately six weeks, to reconstruct the traffic median.

The outside lane along SW 137 Avenue will remain permanently closed throughout the duration of the project. Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions. Drivers should anticipate delays and seek alternate routes if possible. Please drive cautiously in construction zones.
