Single Lane Closure to Occur Near Mile Marker (MM) 35 Tomorrow Night, May 28

Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway

Miami, Fla. – A single lane closure will occur along SR 5/US 1/Overseas Highway near MM 35 tomorrow, May 28, between 7:30 p.m. and midnight, while the contractor safely completes paving repairs under the guardrail and wooden fences, as part of the ongoing roadway and fencing improvement project.

This closure will occur in both the northbound and southbound direction. One lane will remain open in both directions at all times.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
