### Snake Creek Bridge Intermittent Closures to Occur on May 14

*Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway*

**Miami, Fla. – Temporary nighttime intermittent closures will occur on Thursday, May 14, on US 1 at the Snake Creek Bridge between 8 p.m. and midnight**, while the Contractor performs final structural work and restriping. This work requires the drawbridge to be opened and closed for 15 minutes one or more times. Drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge until the bridge reopens. This work is being done as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

**This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
