### Snake Creek Bridge Intermittent Traffic Stoppages to Occur May 7

*Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway*

**Miami, Fla. – Temporary nighttime intermittent closures will occur on Thursday, May 7, on US 1 at the Snake Creek Bridge between 8 p.m. and midnight, while the Contractor performs structural work. This work requires the drawbridge to be opened and closed for 15 minutes one or more times.** Drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge until the bridge reopens. This work is being done as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

**This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.**
