Snake Creek Bridge Single Lane Closure to Occur Tomorrow Night, April 30

Along State Road (SR) 5/US 1/Overseas Highway

Miami, Fla. – There will be a single lane closure on US 1 at the Snake Creek Bridge (MM 85) tomorrow night, Thursday, April 30, while the contractor performs final striping work. The work will be completed between 8 p.m. and midnight.

To perform this work safely, traffic will be maintained by flagmen. Drivers will be required to proceed at a reduced rate of speed through the construction zone. This work is being done as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.

This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unforeseen conditions.
