### Intermittent Bridge Closures to Occur on US1 at Snake Creek Canal Tonight

*Monday, April 13*

**Islamorada, Village of Islands, Fla. – Temporary nighttime closures will occur tonight on US 1 at the Snake Creek Bridge between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.** while the Contractor performs final testing and inspection of the new mechanical and electrical components.

This work requires the drawbridge to be opened and closed briefly one or more times. Drivers will be required to wait on either side of the bridge until the bridge reopens. This work is being done as part of the ongoing bridge rehabilitation project.
