Street Lighting Improvements Along State Road (SR) 968/W Flagler Street Begin June 15 *From SW 84 Avenue to NW 27 Court*

Miami, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin a lighting improvement project the week of June 15, 2020 along SR 968/W Flagler Street from SW 84 Avenue to NW 27 Court. The project will cost an estimated \$939,780.

The work will last roughly seven months and include the following: upgrading existing light poles at selected intersections; removing and/or replacing existing light poles at selected intersections; adding new light poles at selected intersections; installing rail crossing dynamic envelope at the railroad tracks east of SW 71 Avenue.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes and sidewalks, and establish detours at times. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

Please note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
