Temporary Full Closures at State Road (SR) 985/SW 107 Avenue and SW 24 Street/Coral Way Begin Wednesday, September 27

MIAMI, Fla. – On Wednesday, September 27 and Thursday, September 28 between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m., the following detours will be implemented for the installation of the new traffic signal mast arms at the NW and SW corners of the intersection:

NW Corner (Wednesday, September 27):

- Motorists traveling along NB and SB SW 107 Avenue to WB SW 24 Street/Coral Way will be detoured through WB SW 26 Street, and NB SW 109 Avenue.
- Motorists traveling along WB SW 24 Street/Coral Way through the intersection will be detoured through SB SW 107 Avenue, WB SW 26 Street, and NB SW 109 Avenue.

SW Corner (Thursday, September 28):

- Motorists traveling along EB and WB SW 24 Street/Coral Way to SB SW 107 Avenue will be detoured through SB SW 109 Avenue and EB SW 26 Street.
- Motorists traveling along SB SW 107 Avenue through the intersection will be detoured through WB SW 24 Street/Coral Way, SB SW 109 Avenue, and EB SW 26 Street.

Law enforcement will be on site to assist with traffic. Drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible.

Please use caution when traveling through construction zones and note that this schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.

This work is part of the ongoing intersection project along SR 985/SW 107 Avenue at SW 24 Street/Coral Way.
