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FDOT to Host Public Hearing for the Five-Year Tentative Work Program

December 4, 2024

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Public Hearing to present its Five-Year Tentative Work Program for fiscal years 2025/2026 through 2029/2030. Projects programmed in Miami-Dade and Monroe counties over the next five years will be highlighted at this hearing. The event will be held both in-person and virtually on Wednesday, December 4, 2024, starting at 6 p.m.

For Monroe County residents, the Public Hearing will be streamed on Monroe County TV Channel 76 on the date and time listed above.

The Public Hearing for Miami-Dade and Monroe counties will provide an opportunity for the public to ask questions and make comments about the Work Program in general, and specific projects included in the plan.

The hearing will consist of a formal presentation followed by a comment period and open discussion. The presentation will begin promptly at 6 p.m. followed by a live question and answer session. Staff will be available to answer questions and provide assistance. In-person audience members can approach the microphone and ask questions or make comments.
