



Next Steps

- PD&E Study is not moving forward.
- Alternative B-7: At-grade improvements to be considered for implementation:
 - Widening I-95 southbound off-ramp at SW 7th Street
 - Provide a northbound left turn lane at SW 8th Street and SW 2nd Avenue Intersection
 - Closure of SW 4th Avenue at SW 7th Street
 - Convert to two-way traffic SW 4th and SW 3rd Avenue between SW 6th and SW 7th Street
- Coordination with the City of Miami: Alternate routes for bicyclists






