OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has begun a bridge rehabilitation project along SR 5/Overseas Highway over the Channel 5 Bridge (#900098), in Monroe County.

WORK TO BE PERFORMED

- Repairing columns underneath the bridge
- Replacing bridge bearing pads and repairing surrounding concrete

PROJECT SCHEDULE

March 2021 — summer 2026

ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COST

\$13.5 million

LANE AND SHOULDER CLOSURE INFORMATION

Lane closures shall occur only during non-peak hours on non-event days/nights/weekends. Non-peak hours are:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
