FDOT is committed to ensuring that the state's infrastructure serves residents, businesses, and visitors, to meet their needs now and in the future. Key areas include safety, resiliency, supply chain, technology, and workforce development. The following benefits are included in this project:

COMMUNITY

- Removing abandoned driveways within the project limits
- Upgrading lighting and installing new vehicular and pedestrian signals, signage and crosswalks

SAFETY

- Reconstructing damaged sidewalks and driveways
- Removing the concrete median at SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive and NW 5 Avenue
- Widening the median at SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive between NW 5 Court and NW 5 Avenue

RESILIENCY

- Repaving and restriping to preserve the service life of the road
- Upgrading the stormwater drainage system to improve capacity

SUPPLY CHAIN

- Replacing and upgrading pedestrian curb ramps

TECHNOLOGY

- Installing new countdown pedestrian signals and push button poles

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- This project creates opportunities for contractors, which results in positive economic benefits for the workers and the community

LANE CLOSURE INFORMATION

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community. Lanes can be closed during the following hours:

- 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., weekdays and weekends
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- 11:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Friday and Saturday

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Lane closure information will be posted weekly on the department's website, www.southflroads.com.



WHAT TO EXPECT

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects to the community. Temporary lane closures may affect traffic during non-peak hours and non-event days. All detours will be established with clear signage. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.
