The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Six, will host a Public Hearing to discuss the PD&E Study along SR 826/Palmetto Expressway from SR 5/US 1/S Dixie Highway to NW 25th Street in Miami-Dade County. The hearing will begin at 6 p.m. with a formal presentation followed by a public comment period. Virtual attendees will be able to ask or submit comments or questions during the comment period. The hearing will be held simultaneously in person and virtually.

STUDY OBJECTIVE

- Address existing and future traffic needs and improve travel time reliability.
- Enhance overall interchange operations, access, safety and mobility.
- Add highway and interchange lanes to address existing and future traffic demand.

All hearing materials will be available on the project website at www.SouthFLRoads.com/826expresssouth by Monday, February 9, 2026, and at the Westchester Regional Library located at 9445 Coral Way, Miami, FL 33165, Monday to Thursday 9:30 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Friday and Saturday 9:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., closed on Sundays and Federal Holidays. The documents will remain on display through Monday, March 23, 2026.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by FDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. § 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated May 26, 2022, and executed by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and FDOT.

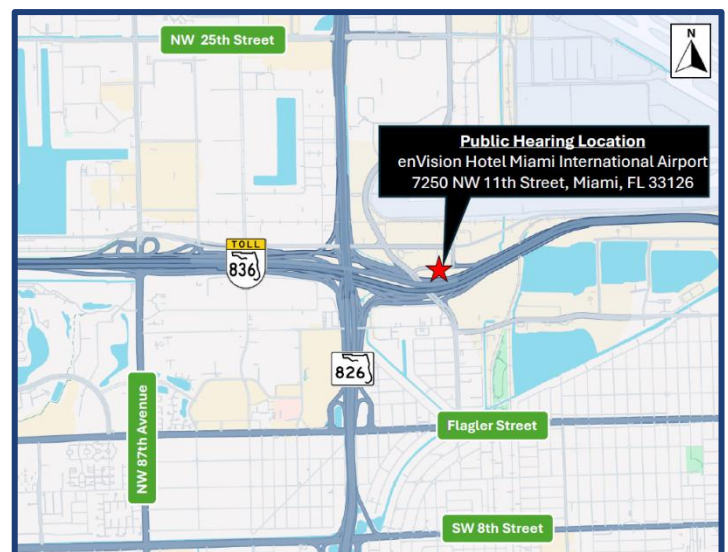
