- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps

- Repaving and restriping to preserve the service life of the road

SUPPLY CHAIN

- Replacing the existing bridge joints on the NW 215 Street/County Line Road bridge over the Florida's Turnpike

TECHNOLOGY

- Enhancing the pedestrian pushbutton signals at NW 13 Court, NW 7 Avenue, and the 1700 block of NW 215 Street/County Line Road

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- This project creates opportunities for contractors, which results in positive economic benefits for the workers and the community

LANE CLOSURE INFORMATION

Travel lanes and sidewalks will be closed during non-peak hours on non-event days.

Non-peak hours are:

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Mondays through Thursdays
- 11 p.m. to 9 a.m., Fridays through Sundays

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Lane closure information will be posted weekly on the department's website, www.southflroads.com.



WHAT TO EXPECT

Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects to the community. Temporary lane closures may affect traffic during non-peak hours and non-event days. All detours will be established with clear signage. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.
