



## SR 860 Miami Gardens Drive Roadway Project Begins on April 7 *From west of NW 27 Avenue to east of NE 5 Avenue*

**MIAMI, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a project on April 7, 2025, along State Road (SR) 860/Miami Gardens Drive from west of NW 27 Avenue to east of NE 5 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. The project will last about 14 months, and the current construction cost is \$9.5 million.

The scope of work for this project includes upgrading lighting, installing new vehicular and pedestrian signals, removing abandoned driveways, adding signage and crosswalks, reconstructing damaged sidewalks and driveways, removing the concrete median at SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive and NW 5 Avenue, widening the median at SR 860/Miami Gardens Drive between NW 5 Court and NW 5 Avenue, replacing pedestrian curb ramps, installing new countdown pedestrian signals and push button poles, upgrading the stormwater system to improve capacity, and repaving and restriping the road.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes, sidewalks, and to establish detours at times. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

Detours will be clearly marked. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.

Thank you for your patience while we work in the area. Remember, wearing a safety belt is the single most effective way to protect people and reduce fatalities in motor vehicle crashes. Always be safe and remain alert while driving in construction zones.
