



SR 932/NW 103 Street/W 49 Street Roadway Project Begins on April 7

From west of W 24 Avenue/NW 82 Avenue to east of W 6 Avenue

MIAMI, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a roadway project on April 7, 2025, along State Road (SR) 932/NW 103 Street/W 49 Street from west of W 24 Avenue/NW 82 Avenue to east of W 6 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. The project will last about one year with a current construction cost of \$8.3 million.

The scope of work for this project includes removing abandoned driveways, reconstructing damaged sidewalks and driveways, upgrading vehicular and pedestrian signals, signage, and crosswalks, replacing and upgrading pedestrian curb ramps, installing new countdown pedestrian signals and pushbutton poles, and repaving and restriping the roadway.

To build this project safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes, sidewalks, and to establish detours at times. Work will be done in stages to minimize construction-related impacts. Drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. Please use caution when traveling through construction zones.

Detours will be clearly marked. Please follow all posted signage and note that this schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.

Thank you for your patience while we work in the area. Remember, wearing a safety belt is the single most effective way to protect people and reduce fatalities in motor vehicle crashes. Always be safe and remain alert while driving in construction zones.
