MAST ARM INSTALLATION

Please be advised that crews will install two new mast arms along State Road (SR) 934/NW 79 Street at NW 32 Avenue on **Wednesday, July 16 and Thursday, July 17 from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., each night.**

To safely complete this work, a single lane will be closed in each direction during nighttime operations. A **full closure** will be in place **during installation of the mast arms.**

Drivers should follow all posted detour signage:

For westbound drivers on SR 934/NW 79 Street:

- Continue westbound on SR 934/NW 79 Street
- Turn right on NW 32 Avenue
- Turn left on NW 80 Terrace
- Turn right on NW 33 Avenue
- Continue straight and turn right to access westbound SR 934/NW 79 Street

For eastbound drivers on SR 934/NW 79 Street:

- Continue eastbound on SR 934/NW 79 Street
- Turn left on NW 32 Avenue
- Turn right on NW 81 Terrace
- Turn right on NW 30 Avenue
- Continue straight and turn left to access eastbound SR 934/NW 79 Street

GENERAL LANE CLOSURE INFORMATION

Travel lanes shall be closed only during non-peak hours on non-event days. Non-peak hours are:

- 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., weekdays and weekends

No construction activities will occur from 8 p.m. to 8 a.m., except during repaving and restriping work and traffic signal installation which will occur from:

- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- 11 p.m. to 7 a.m., Friday and Saturday

Please follow all posted signage and note that drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes if possible. This schedule may change due to bad weather or other unexpected conditions.
